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

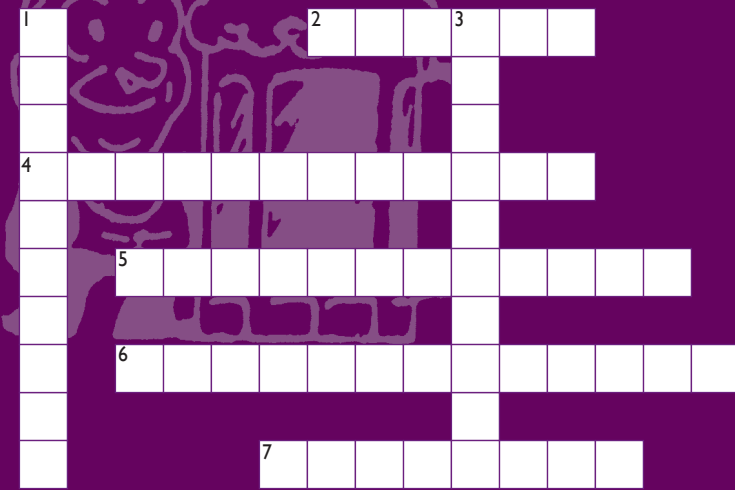

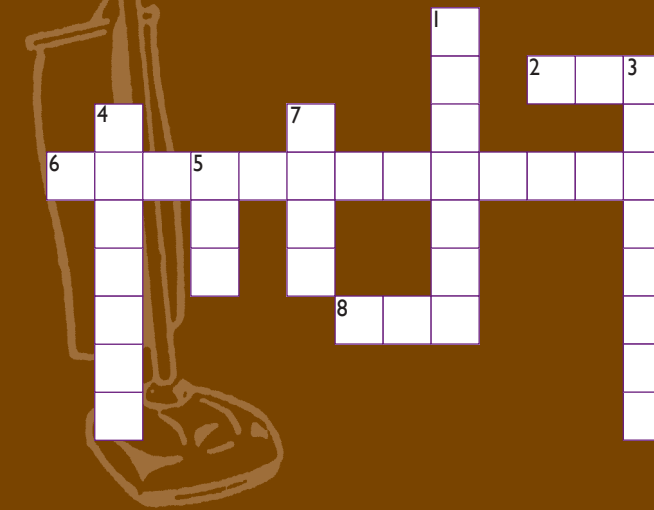
- 2 Microbrewery founded by two brothers and known for its Hefeweizen
- 4 Sponsored by dog-friendly Lucky Labrador Brewing Company, this annual dog wash benefits a local animal emergency hospital
- 5 First Northwest microbrewery to can its craft beer
- 6 Recognized as the West's oldest continuously operating brewery, from 1864-1999
- 7 Based in Hood River, America's only employee-owned brewery

DOWN

- 1 Portland's oldest microbrewery, established by winemaking Ponzi family
- 3 A family of more than 50 (and counting...) breweries, brewpubs, B&Bs, and theater pubs, founded by two brothers

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MUSEUMS

ACROSS

- 2 Oldest museum in the Pacific Northwest
- 6 Stark's shrine to more than 100 dust and dirt suckers
- 8 Housed here are 8.5 million feet of film videotape, 25,000 maps, 30,000 books and 2.5 images of the state

DOWN

- 1 With more than 1,000,000 books on its shelves, this is the world's largest independent bookseller
- 3 A tribute to the ships and seafarers that battled the Willamette and Columbia rivers
- 4 A museum dedicated to the art of rub-a-dub-dub
- 5 Claims to be the only museum on earth with real alien contacts
- 7 Tour the USS Blueback submarine and experience an earthquake at 5.5 on the Richter scale

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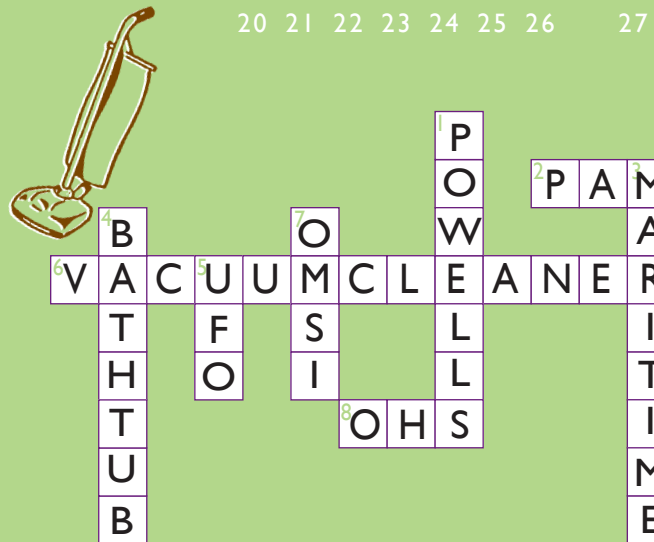
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SEPTEMBER

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ACROSS

- Mystery spot near Gold Hill where tennis balls roll uphill and brooms stand on end
- Home to the Evergreen Aviation Museum and the Spruce Goose
- Cannon Beach is home to this third largest coastal monolith in the world
- Home to the Carousel Museum, the world's largest and most comprehensive collection of carousel horses
- The deepest lake in the U.S.

DOWN

- Oregon boasts more of these towns than any other state
- At 8,000 feet, the deepest river gorge in North America
- Oregon's tallest peak and a dormant volcano
- Home of Frances Gabe and her self-cleaning house
- Aloha is home to this giant rabbit statue and marine supply store's mascot; thousands of daily passersby honk, wave and write him notes

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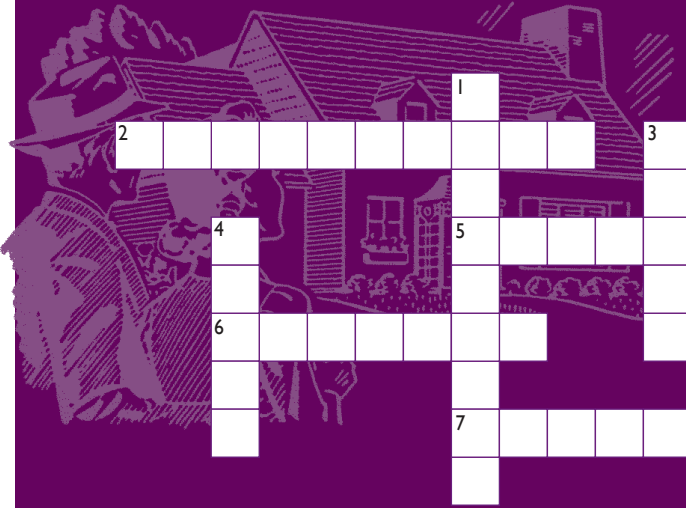

PORTLAND STREETS

ACROSS

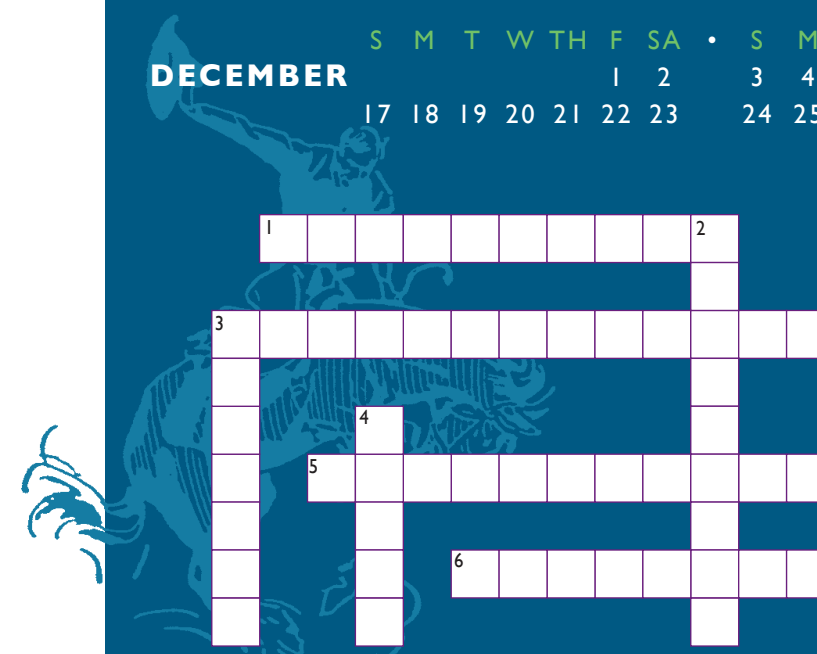
- 2 NW street named for the early developer who gave Portland its name after winning a coin toss
- 5 NW street named for Portland's first Justice of the Peace
- 6 NE street named after the fourth daughter of Queen Victoria and a Canadian Province
- 7 NW street named after sea captain and early Portland settler who laid out NW Portland's Alphabet District

DOWN

- 1 SE street named after novel by Sir Walter Scott
- 3 SW street named after a German colonel who was the state's trade emissary to Japan in the late 1800s
- 4 NE street named for U.S. President who served two terms (1869-1877) and visited Portland three times

ACROSS

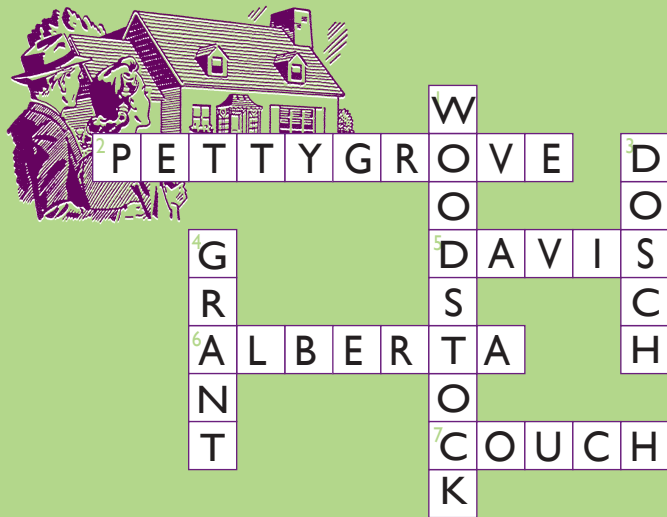
- 1 Day Oregon became a state
